- 3. There is the Mark Masonic Degree which is neither the Second Degree nor the Third in Craft

Each of these Side Degrees has another hierarchical Degree which is an advancement on the previous. Each of these also has a its own Ritual and Secrets known to its Members.

ALLIED TO KING EDWIN CHAPTER NO 660



Craft Masonry is the first stage in Masonry and is the home of the first three Degrees in Masonry. Royal Arch Chapter is considered to be the Fourth Degree in Masonry. Camalodunum Lodge No 938 was established in 1856, initially meeting at the Talbot Hotel before moving to its permanent home adjoining the Church Rooms. King Edwin Chapter was Consecrated soon afterwards. A Grand Lodge renumbering of all Lodges in 1867 saw the number change to No 660.



Masons and Charity - A Lodge is not a charitable institution but a private club which the members raise money amongst themselves for good causes and local charities. Regional and National charity chests can also be petitioned for assistance in varying degrees.



Membership - All Masons have to have a belief in a Supreme Being and a genuine desire to be more useful to their fellow men through whatever means.

Masonry is about making good men better, friendship and socialising. It doesn't suit everyone and they have to want to join - not be invited.
